

**Limitations on Frequency and Dollar Amounts of Transactions.** The total amount of purchases that you can perform in any single day is limited to the Daily Purchase Limit and the total amount of cash withdrawals (including withdrawals from a teller inside a bank office) that you can perform in any single day is limited to the Daily Withdrawal Limit (as defined in the table below). The maximum aggregate value of your Card Account(s) may not exceed **\$10,000** at any time. The maximum value will be determined by aggregating the activity and value of all Card Accounts you may have with the Program. For security reasons, we may further limit the number or dollar amount of transactions you can make with your Card. The following grid is provided in order to highlight the frequency and limitations of cardholder transactions in a single day or additional time frame if warranted:

<b>Transaction/load type</b>	<b>Maximum amount</b>
Maximum balance on the card	<b>\$10,000</b> (includes all cash and direct deposit loads)
Withdrawals	<b>\$3,000</b> per day (includes all bank teller, ATM and cash back from POS purchases) (the “Daily Withdrawal Limit”)
Cash withdrawal (ATM)	<b>\$500</b> per day
Cash withdrawal (bank teller)	<b>\$500</b> per day
Purchases (POS)	<b>\$2,500</b> per day (the “Daily Purchase Limit”)
Send money	<b>\$500</b> per day (includes all cash and direct deposit loads)
Value loads	Any combination of the load types listed below to not exceed the maximum balance of <b>\$5,000</b> per day
Direct deposits	<b>\$5,000</b> per day
Cash deposits	<b>\$1,500</b> per day and \$5,000 per month
Card-to-card transfers	<b>\$500</b> per day
ACH deposits (bank-to-card transfers)	<b>\$500</b> per day (includes all cash and direct deposit loads)
